### **\*Call to Worship – From Isaiah 6:1-8**

- L: It was in the year King Uzziah died that I saw the Lord. He was sitting on a lofty throne, and the train of his robe filled the Temple.
- P: Attending him were mighty seraphim, each having six wings. With two wings they covered their faces, with two they covered their feet, and with two they flew.**
- L: They were calling out to each other, “Holy, Holy, Holy is the Lord of Heaven’s Armies! The whole earth is filled with His glory!”
- P: Their voices shook the Temple to its foundations, and the entire building was filled with smoke.**
